

Cross Trail Outfitters Catawba River Basin Gun Raffle Rules

1. Limit of 1,500 tickets to be sold. Tickets are numbered 0001 – 1500. There are a limited number of additional free tickets for the Buy Five Get One Free deal.
2. One ticket for a \$20 donation or make a \$100 donation and receive six tickets.
3. All prizes are new firearms that have never been registered.
4. By obtaining a raffle ticket you attest that you are a law-abiding citizen of good moral character, may legally possess the firearm(s) won, have intention of using the firearm(s) only in a legal and safe manner, and will or already have obtained instruction on the safe use and operation of the firearm(s) won.
5. All firearms won are subject to availability, and CTO Catawba River Basin reserves the right to make substitutions of equal or greater value.
6. Winner's name and gun won will be posted on the CTO Catawba River Basin website: teamctonc.wildapricot.org/crb
7. You must be at least 18 years old and a legal resident of the United States to purchase a ticket.
8. Winners must be at least 18 years old to take possession of a rifle or shotgun, and at least 21 years old to take possession of a handgun.
9. Prizes are not transferrable. The person designated on the ticket must claim the prize.
10. Winners will be notified, using the name, email and/or phone number that the purchaser has written on the ticket stub or requested to be on the ticket stub. ALL PRIZES MUST BE CLAIMED AND TRANSFER COMPLETED WITHIN 15 DAYS OF THE SCHEDULED DATE THE TICKET IS DRAWN.
11. Raffle is void where prohibited.
12. All Federal Bureau of Alcohol and Tobacco and Firearms rules apply.
13. All firearm transfers will be done through a Federal Firearms Licensed (FFL) dealer, and all applicable Federal and State laws will apply, including the state laws for the legal residence of winning ticket holder.
14. Winners will be responsible for any applicable Federal, State, and local taxes.
15. In the event winners need or wish to have the firearm(s) that was won transferred to their local FFL dealer closer to their residence, shipping and any other additional costs involved with the transfer will be the responsibility of the winner.
16. Winners may be required to verify that ownership of the firearm(s) won is legal in their state, city, or town, prior to taking possession of won prizes.
17. Winners will receive firearm(s) directly from a FFL dealer only. All applicable laws will apply.
18. CTO limits any and all liability to the purchase price of ticket purchased.
